# Scouts | Terrain – How to: Conclude an Activity



#### How to – Finalise a Program Activity & Awarding Program Essentials – Milestone Progressions

To finalise a Program activity, event or camp there are a few steps involved so as to finalise properly and to award Participates and part award Assists and Leads in the Program Essentials Milestones. The Organiser of this activity or any member of the Unit Council (including adult Leaders) will be able to finalise these activities. It is suggested this occurs at the end of a Program night or event with the Youth Members who participated are still present.

#### Step 1

Navigate to the Program Calendar (found on the Programming tab on the left hand side navigation bar in Scouts I Terrain)

## Step 2

Select a program activity, event or camp that has already occurred – let's say it is the 24<sup>th</sup> of August 2020 and your Patrol, Unit or Group did an activity together today 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020. Go into that activity by clicking on the program for that day in the calendar.

There will be three selection menus at the top – Activity Details, Attendance and Review.

### Step 3

Select the attendance tab up the top of the page – select which members attended there are two ways to do this.

- 1. Click on the circle next to the name heading at the top of the list. This will select all members and then you can untick which ones did not attend
- 2. Individually select who attended by clicking on the circle next to their name.
- 3. Press save down the bottom right of the page otherwise Participate credits will not be awarded.

- 3. Select from the three options as to how the activity was? (Great, Okay or Boring)
