

Scouts | Terrain – How to: Install Scouts | Terrain



How to download Scouts | Terrain to your device

Scouts | Terrain is a responsive web app. This means you don't need to download it from an app store, because it's accessible from any web browser!

If you're on a mobile device, you can download Scouts | Terrain straight to your device. If you're on a computer or laptop, it's a little trickier. Here's a list of what's supported:

- **MacOS:** All Chromium web browsers such as Google Chrome or Brave
- **Windows:** Most web browsers (such as Chrome or Edge)
- **Apple mobile devices (such as an iPhone/iPad):** Safari
- **Android mobile devices (such as a Samsung phone or a tablet):** Most web browsers (such as Chrome)

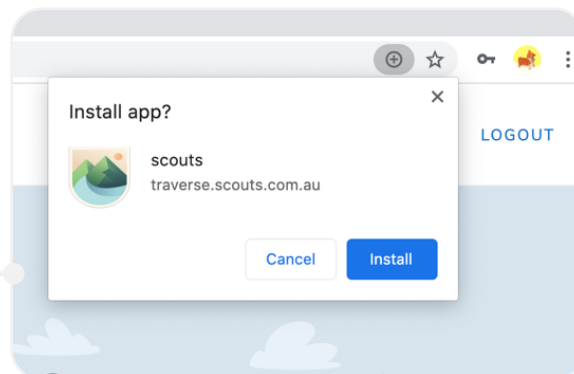
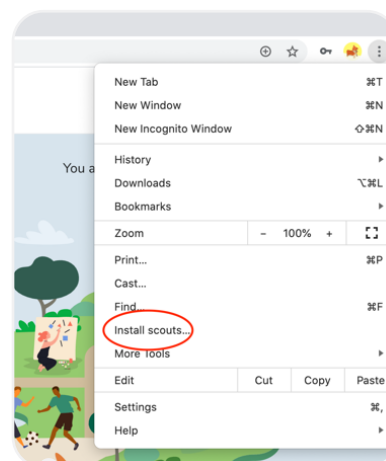
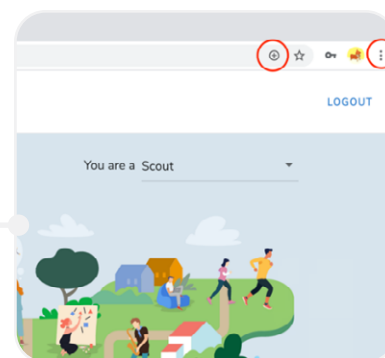
Scouts | Terrain works just as well inside your web browser as it does after you've downloaded it. For some users, they might have a preference to download it and launch from the icon.

Here's some instructions, depending on your device & browser:

MacOS – Google Chrome (or variant)

1. Open your web browser and go to <https://terrain.scouts.com.au>
2. Log in to Scouts | Terrain
3. In your browser bar, next to your URL, you can see some buttons (shown in the image right). You can either click the circular plus button, or the three dots & then 'install Scouts | Terrain' from the menu.
4. This will give you a prompt to install Scouts | Terrain:
5. Click Install
6. Scouts | Terrain will now open in a new window – as it's own app!
7. In future, to open Scouts | Terrain you can either visit the website or click the app icon you've just installed.

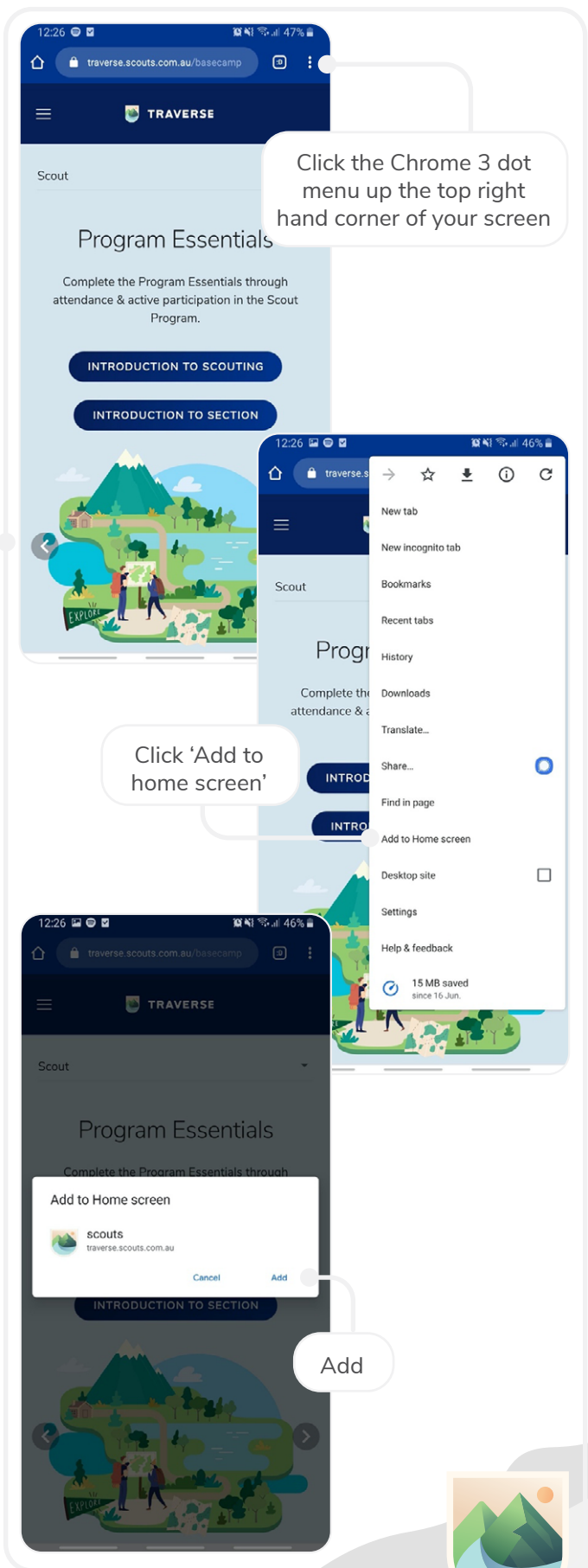


iPhone/iPad – Safari

1. On your device, open your Safari browser and head to <https://terrain.scouts.com.au>
2. Once you've logged in, and visited Basecamp - you're ready to proceed
3. In your iOS menu bar (where you have the back/forward arrow, and the tabs view) there is also a box with an arrow button.
4. Click this button and then in the menu choose to 'Add to home screen'
5. Make sure the name is Scouts | Terrain, and click 'Add' in the top right
6. Back to your iOS home screen, you should see the Scouts | Terrain icon, alongside your other apps. Simply click on Scouts | Terrain to open it straight up.

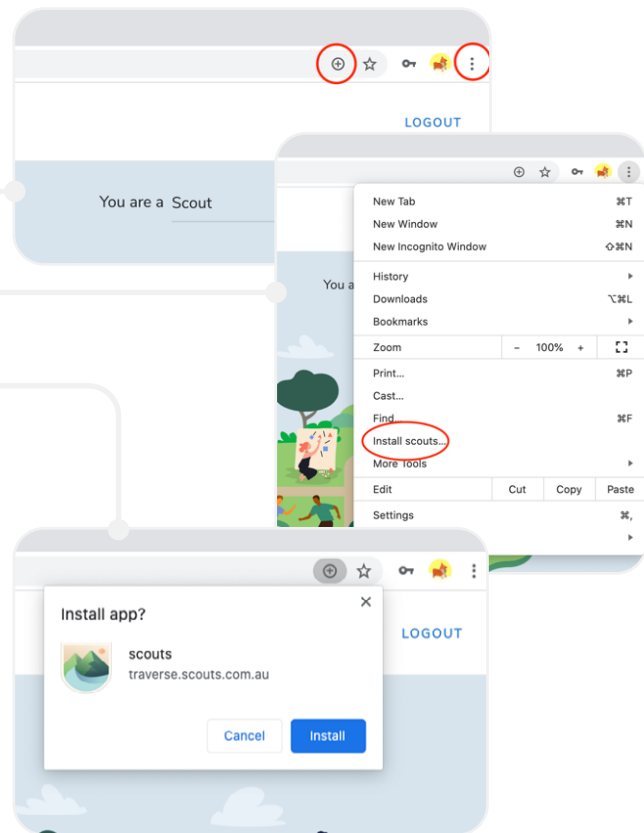
Android Device

1. Open your web browser (such as Chrome) and visit <https://terrain.scouts.com.au>
2. Once you've logged in, and visited Basecamp - you're ready to proceed
3. Back on your android home screen, you should see the Scouts | Terrain icon, alongside your other apps. Just click Scouts | Terrain to launch it!



Windows Computer – Chrome

1. Open your web browser and go to <https://terrain.scouts.com.au>

Windows Computer – Edge

7. In future, to open Scouts | Terrain you can either visit the website or click the app icon you've just installed, from your desktop.
