



# The latest news and information August 27th, 2020

### When will I get access to Scouts | Terrain?

- Members that used Pioneer Tracker will have access to Scouts | Terrain from late afternoon Friday, August 28th!
- Progressively, all other members will be added to the system, so stay tuned for these announcements.
- Pioneer Tracker users do not have to rush to start using Scouts | Terrain. The only deadline is the closure of Pioneer Tracker. It is okay to wait until the full system is up and running.

The current timeline is -

Monday 31/8	Pioneer Tracker shuts down
By Friday 18/9	Adult Unit Leaders given access
By Friday 2/10	Youth members given access

#### Pioneer Tracker:

- Pioneer Tracker closes on Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup> Have you download all reports necessary to record all elements of the Achievement Pathways etc. completed by unit members?
- (We are awaiting information to determine the exact shut off time we are hoping it is Canadian time meaning 7 am EST Tuesday. Any new information will be posted in the Scouts | Terrain Facebook group.)

#### System development and updates:

- When the Pioneer Tracker 'release' occurs Friday, August 28th, there will be incomplete aspects of the system. This list is progressively decreasing, but currently includes:
  - o Reviewing, finalising and awarding of all Achievement Pathways components
  - Group Life/Unit Life this is a place where the Unit Council and adult leaders can see and track the attendance and progress of all members in the Group/Unit
  - My Progress this is the place where youth members can see what they have achieved, and how close they are to completing specific elements. This will be accessed from Basecamp.
  - o Adult administration for bulk achievements this will enable Unit Leaders and adult leaders to collectively award/complete OAS achievements for multiple members simultaneously. Note: this applies to Stages 1-3 in the OAS only at this point.

- Logbook this is where youth can track their adventurous activities, as well as Camper and Walkabout awards
- Additional Awards as the name suggests, this is where the WOSM Better World Framework (Messengers of Peace, Environment and Scouts of the World) and other additional awards will be displayed and tracked
- o Commenting this function will first appear in Programming, and will help in planning and preparing for activities and events
- o Business Insights tools for reporting in Scouts | Terrain. These reports will improve overtime as we learn how people use Scouts | Terrain to support the program.
- We anticipate that over the next two weeks, a large portion of these items will be finalised and available in Scouts | Terrain for users to enjoy.

## Support: (This is new information)

- The new Support page will be live from late Friday, August 28th.
- We are now using a service desk support system.
  - You will be able to click a 'help' button within Scouts | Terrain, instead of emailing yp.support@scouts.com.au.
  - Responding to user support requests will become more efficient and improve our sharing of these requests with the development/maintenance team.
