Setup your Group and Units



Is this your first time logging in to Scouts|Terrain – need to setup the Group and Units?

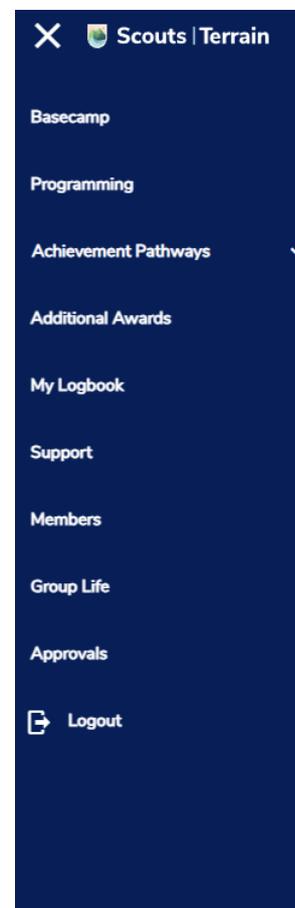
If your group is just getting started with Terrain there are a few things to do so you can get up and running.

Step 1

- Login to Scouts Terrain at <https://terrain.scouts.com.au> (refer to our Support document on logging in if you haven't yet logged in before)

Step 2

- Navigate to the members section by using the navigation bar on the left hand side and selecting **Members**
- From here you will see the name of your Scout Group and a list of all the members of the group
- There are three tabs you can view information from at this point
 - Group – lists all group members
 - Units – shows the units within the group
 - Patrols – shows the patrols within the group



Units

- Select Units
- If units are setup here, it means at some point in the past they have been setup by a user
- If no units are setup, click the blue **Create Unit** button on the right hand side of the screen
 - Enter the Unit name (i.e. Tuesday Cubs)
 - Enter the Section (i.e. Cubs)
 - Click save
 - This will now generate a new unit in the system called **Tuesday Cubs**
 - Group

Patrols

- Select Patrols
- If none are displayed, then no patrols have been setup
- Click the blue **Create Patrol** button
- Enter a patrol name and the Unit this patrol is associated with
- Click save

Add Members to Units and Patrols

- Click on the **Units** tab
- Click into one of the Units you have created
- On the right hand side of the screen click **Add Member**
- Use this interface to add members by name. You can also add members from outside of your Group if you have their member number
- Once you've selected all the members click add
- Members will now appear in the unit list
- You can assign them a Patrol if these have been setup
- You can assign them a duty
 - Scout (Youth)
 - Patrol Leader or Assistant Patrol Leader (Youth)
 - Unit Leader (Youth)
 - Adult Leader (Adult)
- You can mark them as a member of the Unit Council which gives additional approval and programming access in the system
