

Navigating to and around Outdoor Adventure Skills

Step 1

Log in to Scouts|Terrain using the user guide **Logging in for the first time**

Step 2

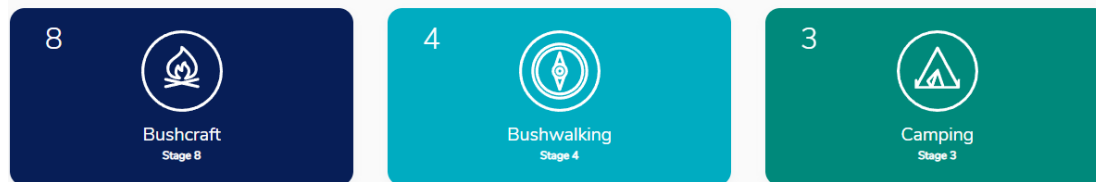
Click the Outdoor Adventure Skills (OAS) image on the basecamp screen

Note – as an adult leader you may need to navigate to members and manage achievement pathways for a member if you wish to mark off items for the member

Step 3

Your Progress

Core skills



The interface will show with icons that show current progress, the approval status of items and items that have been awarded including which section they have been awarded in.

Step 4

Select an OAS activity i.e. Bushcraft and then the relevant stage number i.e. Stage 1

Step 5

Once in an activity stage you can

- Read the 'i-statements' to know what needs to be completed
- Use the guidance statements by clicking the info button. This provides more information on completing that i-statement
- Upload supporting documents such as a trip plan, video, photos showing you completing those i-statements
- Update your logbook by adding a verifier to statements by pressing add verifier (you need to enter name and contact details)
- Submit the stage for progression to the Unit Council for consideration

Notes on OAS

You can only work on a few stages of OAS at a time – starting at Stage 1 or wherever you have been baselined at.

Once submitted to the Unit Council, two members will need to approve, or request improvement to push your submission through.
